A world where all women and girls are inspired and empowered to achieve their full potential, leading to positive social change.

Our Mission:

To provide world-class personal and career development, helping disadvantaged and vulnerable women and girls to achieve their ambitions and financial independence. We do this by leveraging the power of an influential community and collaborative partnerships in the public, private and charitable sectors.



The empowerment of women and girls is critical in breaking the cycle of gender inequality. Investing in women and girls is key to improving economies and stabilising communities around the world.

Gender disparities exist in every country. Women and girls face inequality at home, at work, and in public life. They are disproportionately affected by discrimination, violence, and exploitation.

Risks faced by women and girls diminish proportionally to their financial independence. World Bank and OECD research has consistently shown that women's economic empowerment is a key component of achieving long-term development goals.

GAPS IN CHARITY SECTOR

There is significant investment in addressing **other** specific and urgent needs affecting women & girls. There is a lack of multi-agency partnering to combine resources, expertise and ideas.

LIMITATIONS IN GOVERNMENT SUPPORT

Government bodies are generally focused on urgent and targeted issues. Government support and resources are often finite and age-restricted.

LACK OF FREE ONGOING SUPPORT

There is a lack of services which offer ongoing personal and career development to women & girls of all ages and stages. Often, free access to this type of support ends at school level, leaving women unsupported as they navigate the world of work, and the turbulence of adult life.

We focus on the end goal of financial independence for all women & girls who come to us for help..






The women & girls we serve

The women & girls we help come from disadvantaged backgrounds and experience barriers in achieving their full potential and financial independence.


Our service welcomes all women, including trans women.

We particularly support women & girls who face:


- Disadvantaged backgrounds

The Inspiring Futures Academy

The Inspiring Futures Academy develops personal and professional capabilities in women & girls from disadvantaged backgrounds. The programmes are offered free of charge to all beneficiaries.

- The academy provides mentoring, workshops, virtual learning, events and work opportunities.
- The academy provides development and growth opportunities for women & girls aged 16 and over. There is no upper age limit.
- There are four levels, each offering learning opportunities and the chance to gain certificates, bringing participants closer to their ambitions and financial independence.





100% of participants were satisfied with the workshops



94% reported improvement in skills development



84% reported feeling more confident having participated in the IFA Level 1 programme



85% of beneficiary goals were being met for those in mentoring relationships

What we provide



WORKSHOPS

We offer a range of live sessions covering a variety of topics at various levels, hosted by internal team members and inspiring guest speakers.



MENTORING

We match mentees with the right mentor, who can use their expertise and experience to help the mentee achieve her goals and aspirations.



VIRTUAL RESOURCES

We have carefully created a selection of useful resources which can be accessed anytime, anywhere, online or through our downloadable app.



WORK EXPERIENCE

We provide participants with access to career tasters, work placements and work experience, broadening career horizons.



SUPPORTIVE COMMUNITY

We are here to support participants for the long term. We will create a safe space in which you can learn and grow.



PSYCHOMETRICS

We offer questionnaires to help participants build greater selfawareness, understand their strengths and guide their futures.



INTERNATIONAL PROJECTS

In developed countries like the UK and Ireland, our programmes are ready to thrive. In developing countries, we often need to work with other organisations to help establish the foundations for our programmes to be accessible and successful.



SOUTH AFRICA

In South-Africa we have built a fully equipped technology classroom with learning curriculum, an early childhood learning centre, creating a safe a secure centre for education and wellbeing.

KENYA

We have invested in several grassroots projects in Kenya, including self-sustaining school business farms and water sanitation. This has led to job creation, improved health and nutrition, and school participation for women and girls.

CHARLOTTE UNITED KINGDOM

When single-mother, <u>Charlotte</u> joined our programmes she described herself as being at her lowest point.

With the help of a mentor, she was able to pursue her goals of going to university.


